Hospital Enhancements

Critical Decision Unit Buildout – Wellstar Paulding Hospital: A designated unit designed for patients who come to the Emergency Department and may need additional tests, treatment or observation requiring them to stay longer than a typical emergency department visit. The CDU helps to meet increased demand for emergency care in the area.

LUCAS Systems – Wellstar Cobb Hospital: An easy-to-use, automated chest compression device that helps emergency workers deliver lifesaving care to patients in cardiac arrest.

Neuro Biplane – Wellstar North Fulton Hospital: A hybrid operating room, offering bi-plane imaging capabilities and staffing support that make stroke and neuro critical care available faster and closer to home.
