EMERGENCY & TRAUMA

- **New ambulances** equipped with advanced telemedicine and automated CPR machines
- **Critical care and surgical beds** enhance care for burn trauma and emergency patients at WellStar Cobb Hospital

PEDIATRICS

- An **Infant Simulator** trains staff serving 100,000+ pediatric patients in WellStar's Emergency Departments each year
- Evidence-based reading program supporting early childhood development in partnership with WellStar pediatric offices

ONCOLOGY

- The **Imogene Walraven Waldrop Infusion Center** provides patients with life-saving resources and amenities close to home
- More than **1700 free mammograms** and diagnostic services were provided to uninsured or underinsured patients

WOMEN'S HEALTH

- **The Women's Center** at WellStar Douglas Hospital features 13 new patient rooms and a **Level II Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU)**
- Specialized **NICU cribs** more comfortably accommodate long-term babies and co-bedding twins

HOSPITAL ENHANCEMENTS

- New **Hospital Chapels** promote spiritual healing among hospital guests and team members
- The **Integrative Health Employee Renewal Center**, the first of its kind in Georgia, offers mindfulness techniques and reinforces self-care among team members

SPECIALTY CARE

- **530 lung pillows** were provided to patients following thoracic surgery to reduce their pain and chances of pneumonia
- Upgraded **Cardiac Rehabilitation** equipment and patient resources promote healing and improve outcomes

CARING FOR THOSE IN NEED

- Safe Kids donated nearly **700 car seats** to families in need
- **School Health Programs** offer classes in creating healthy habits to nearly **70,000 local students**

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

- **Mental Health First Aid Training** was offered to community groups
- Donated **equipment and AED training** better prepares community organizations in emergency scenarios

TEAM MEMBER GIVING

- **120 WellStar families** received emergency financial assistance after experiencing a catastrophic event
- **99 educational scholarships** were awarded to team members pursuing degrees in healthcare-related fields
